Short scientific cv

In his Ph.D. he focussed on Dutch word formation. Later on he explored a second domain of interest: the sociolinguistics of Dutch, and variational linguistics in general: Dutch as a pluricentric language, language variation in Flanders (Belgian Dutch, colloquial language, language attitudes), multilingualism, language legislation, English as a lingua franca, language ideologies.
